

This is a lesson to teach/reinforce quarter note, eighth note, quarter rest, and sixteenth note rhythms using Kodaly rhythm syllables.

Students will use pretzels to practice writing rhythms.

(Pipe cleaners or straws cut to size can also be used)

- 1. Start by having students place the pretzels on the gray lines to create the rhythms. Have students clap aloud saying the rhythm syllables.
- 2. Once mastered, have students use their pretzels to create the rhythms on the sheets without the gray lines.
  - 3. Finally, students can use their pretzels to create their own rhythms!

I recommend laminating these sheets and wiping them down after each use.
